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
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CHAPTER I

THE PROBLEM OF ENROLMENT

Since 1920, Montana has had a somewhat static population but the years between census reports show marked changes in public school enrolment totals. Montana's population¹ in 1930 was 537,606 with a public school enrolment of 120,385². In 1940, the state's population was 559,456 as compared with a school enrolment of 106,048. Here is shown a decrease in enrolment with an increase in population. The state population in 1950 was 587,259 while the public school enrolment decreased again to 105,600.

In 1940, 62 percent of Montana's population was rural as compared with 56 percent in 1950, a change of 6 percent.³ This decrease in rural population indicates a population shift from rural to urban.

Statement of the Problem

This study was developed to secure and analyze public school enrolment data for two decades, 1930-1950, for the following purposes: (1) to determine the survival rates from birth to the first grade and from grade to grade, after the first, and from the survival rates to show the holding power of the public schools in the three economic areas of the state; (2) to trace the growth and decline of public school enrolments in the three economic areas of the state; (3) to estimate on the basis of enrolments and survival rates the probable future enrolments in each county, economic area, and the state.

Implications of the Study

The grade enrolments are history but they can be used collectively with other data to answer many questions concerning Montana's public schools. Those pupils who entered school in 1939-1940 and continued were enrolled in the twelfth grade in 1950-1951.

It is required by law that the county superintendents make annual reports of school statistics in their counties to the State Department of Public Instruction.⁴ These

reports have been checked and filed away. The State Department has made summaries from these reports, but the public school enrolment data have never been collected by counties or areas into a useful form.

Since this information can be useful in pointing out problems as to the progress of Montana education it seems desirable to collect and compile the enrolment data into a useable form. The state, area, and county data relating to the percentage of drop outs and the possible future enrolments, as reported by this study, should encourage educators of Montana to study their particular systems to discover the reasons for drop outs and take steps to alleviate some of them.

The drop out problem has always troubled educators. In Montana, a child must attend school, public or private, until he has completed the eighth grade or reached the age of sixteen or it is proven after the age of fourteen that his wages are necessary to the family's support.⁵ The problem of drop out is not so acute in the elementary grades because of compulsory education laws. Most of the decrease or increase in enrolment in the elementary grades is due to the migration of parents and other factors which cause a child to discontinue school temporarily or permanently or to retardation.

Many local studies have been made to show at what grade levels the greatest number of pupils are dropping out. Compilation of data by economic areas revealed trends which were prevalent in one area of the state as compared to another. The percentage of pupils who start in the first grade and actually continue on through high school is lower for some areas of the state than others and the reasons behind these facts should be studied in detail at the local level.

Some Montana schools are reporting crowded conditions despite the fact that the state had fewer pupils enrolled in 1950-1951 than in 1930-1931. By using the data collected in the analysis of school enrolments it is possible to tell approximately what the enrolment will be in the future, assuming the continuation of present trends. Many school systems have taken steps to alleviate certain pressures caused by crowded conditions only to find the situation worse and still more costly. All information that is available should be studied and plans should be laid for Montana's future education program.

Sources of Data and Method of Procedure

Enrolment data. The collection of public school original enrolments from the County Superintendent's Annual reports filed in the State Department of Public Instruction involved a great deal of effort. A chart was made for each

county. On this chart each grade's enrolment for all available years was recorded. To keep errors to a minimum two people worked together and constantly checked the collected data. The corresponding births, six years previous to grade enrolments, were collected from the State Board of Health and placed on the chart for each county.

To obtain enrolment data from the private and parochial schools was impossible since this data were not recorded in any central location. Parochial and private school totals were available for the state as a whole but not by counties or grades within the counties.

Two terms which will appear frequently are "survival rates" and "holding power". Survival rate is the percent of pupils going from one grade to another, while holding power refers to the number of pupils continuing through a specified number of grades.

Because data for some years were not available for every county the survival rates for each county for each grade were computed and averaged for the last five recorded school years, 1945-1946 to 1950-1951. Since births are recorded by place of occurrence only, the birth to the first grade survival rate was figured on a ten year average, with the exception of those counties which recorded so few births to make this method impractical. In these cases, a ten year average of grade one enrolments was used.

The number of pupils can be traced from grade one to grade twelve. Those pupils who enrolled in grade one in 1939 were the same group which was enrolled in grade twelve in 1950. What percent of them actually went through eleven grades and started the twelfth? The average survival rates for each county as shown in Table II were averaged for the six economic sub-areas to determine the holding power for the twelve grades in public school as shown in Table IV. An index of one hundred was used as the basis for the first grade. The percentage of survival between grade one and two was multiplied by one hundred to determine the index of the number of pupils enrolled in grade two. The survival rate percentage between grade two and three was then multiplied by the grade two index to produce the grade three enrolment. This process was continued through the twelfth grade.

Limitations of school census and birth data. School census reports have the census data grouped into two parts: children who are six to twenty one years old and those from zero to six. Births in Montana are recorded by the State Board of Health, by counties, for every year. These birth data were limited by the fact that, until 1946, they were recorded by place of occurrence only. In 1946, this practice was changed and the birth of a child was recorded by residence of the mother and place of occurrence, however, since this practice has been in effect only a short time the number of births recorded by residence of the mother could not be

compared with the number entering the first grade six years later.

State economic areas. Since this state is the third largest in area and is in forty-third place as to population the question arises as to how county data should be grouped. In 1950, the Bureau of the Census divided all of the states into economic areas on the basis of certain significant factors within each particular area. Montana is divided into three principal areas for the purpose of population studies and each of these is divided into two areas for agricultural purposes.⁶ It is into these areas that the enrolment analysis has been placed.

Enrolment data were grouped by economic areas for grades one to eight and nine to twelve to show changes in the school population. The variation in school population within each of the three areas is shown in the percentage change in the public school enrolment totals as shown in table I. The variations in holding power among the economic areas for grades one through twelve and nine through twelve are shown in Tables IV and V.

Estimated enrolments. The study of public school enrolment data for an entire state makes it necessary to eliminate or disregard factors which may be studied locally in more detail in other studies. The factors which cause pupil to leave school are not considered in this study.

To predict what the possible future enrolments will be is very hazardous because of unforeseeable situations. The estimation of future enrolments can be done on the basis of past experience.

The predicted county public school enrolments for each grade were determined by applying the average calculated survival rates for the five year period, 1945-1950 to the last known enrolment figure for each grade in the school year 1950-1951. The ten year average survival rate from birth to the first grade for the years 1940 to 1950 applied to the number of births for each year from 1945 through 1950 gave the estimated first grade enrolments for 1951-1952 through 1956-1957.⁷ The births for 1951 to 1953 are based on ten year averages of births from 1940 to 1950.

The public school enrolment data by grades for each county are given in the appendix along with the birth data by place of occurrence and the estimated future public school enrolments, alphabetically by counties, in the six economic sub-areas.

CHAPTER II

PUBLIC SCHOOL ENROLMENT ANALYSIS

The public school enrolment history tells a story, and by checking that story it is possible to predict what future enrolments may be. Montana's public school enrolments, analyzed for survival rates and holding power, show the trends within the state. By grouping the county enrolment data into areas it is possible to show how the trends vary among different parts of the state.

Economic Areas Defined

The United States Bureau of the Census, in 1950, divided the states into economic areas. This was done on the basis of certain significant characteristics which distinguished one area from another. The factors considered were: industrial and commercial activities. Demographic, climatic, physiographic, and cultural factors as well as factors pertaining more directly to the production and exchange of agricultural and nonagricultural goods, were considered. For collecting and tabulating statistical data, an increasing need was found for a set of areas, intermediate

in size, between counties and states.¹ The areas within the state follow county boundaries. On this basis Montana is divided as shown in Figure I.

The use of these economic areas makes it possible to study enrolment patterns in Montana on an intermediate basis between county and the state. The areas are as homogeneous as possible in a state so varied in geography, industry, and culture. The numbered economic areas in Montana, followed by letters in the lower case (e.g., 1a, 1b), are combined for population tabulations, but retained separately for agricultural tabulations.² In determining holding power for this study the agricultural areas were used. The map of Montana on page 11 shows the division of the six economic sub-areas in the state and the three major areas of the state.

Enrolment and Birth Data

On or before September first of each year, the county superintendents must turn in to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction their annual report for the preceding school year.³ The form for this report is made up

by the State Department of Public Instruction. This form has not been changed since its adoption in 1910. The form consists of two parts, financial and statistical. The original enrolments for each county for each school year, by grades, are recorded in one section of this report. The enrolment data contained herein were taken from these reports. There is a minimum of duplication of enrolments from county to county. For example; if a child enrolls in Beaverhead county in September of a particular school year he will be counted as an original enrollee. If this pupil then moves to another county to finish the term or continues to move from county to county or perhaps out of the state, he is still an original enrollee in Beaverhead county for that year. However, out of state pupils will be counted as original enrolments whenever they enter the state and in which ever county they reside.

In the tables for each county birth data by place of occurrence are recorded with the year the children should actually start school. Those children born in 1924 were eligible to start school six years later or in the school year 1930-1931. The State Board of Health records all births in Montana and publishes the totals by counties in its biennial report. School census data are collected by the clerk of the board of trustees in each district. He is required by law to make an accurate tabulation of all children between the ages of zero and twenty-one actually residing

in his district. Since these data are not broken down into one year age groups, the birth data were used by years and counties. The enrolment data and the birth data are included in the appendices, A, B, C, D, E, and F, by counties in alphabetical order by economic sub-areas.

Enrolment History By Areas

The original enrolment data were grouped for grades one through eight and nine through twelve for every five year period from 1930 to 1950 as shown in Table I.

Area 1. In Area 1, public school enrolments for grades one to eight decreased steadily from 1930 to 1945. The increase from 1945 to 1950 brought the elementary enrolment 6.2 percent above the previous high in 1930. The enrolments in grades nine to twelve show a steady increase from 1930 to 1940 but decreased sharply between 1940 and 1945. In the five year period between 1945 and 1950 the high school enrolment for the area increased, bringing the 1950 enrolment to 7.3 percent higher than it was in 1930.

Area 2. In Area 2 public school enrolments for grades one to eight decreased rapidly from 1930 to 1945. After an increase from 1945 to 1950, the 1950 enrolment showed a total of 27 percent less than the previous high in 1930. The grade nine to twelve enrolments increased from 1930 to 1935. Since then, the grade nine to twelve

enrolments have declined until in 1950 they were 10 percent less than the 1930 level.

Area 3. In Area 3, public school enrolments for grades one to eight decreased from 1930 to 1945. The increase from 1945 to 1950 showed the elementary enrolment 17.9 percent less than the previous high in 1930. The grade nine to twelve enrolments increased from 1930 to 1935, with a decline from 1935 to 1945. From 1945 to 1950 the grade nine to twelve enrolments increased; however, the enrolment was 1.3 percent less than in 1930.

State trends. The public school enrolment totals for the state of Montana decreased from 1930 to 1945 and increased from 1945 to 1950; however, the state totals were 10.8 percent lower in 1950 than the high in 1930. Area 1 is the only area of the state that had a larger 1950 elementary and high school enrolment than it had in 1930. Area 2 showed the greatest decline in elementary and high school enrolments. Area 3 enrolments declined, but not as rapidly as in Area 2.

Those children born in the period 1932 through 1936 were those who started high school in the period 1941 through 1944. This was the low tide for high school enrolments. Since the recovery from the depression, the birth rate has been steadily rising and the annual number of births has increased over 50 percent. The children born since 1946 were not in school in 1950-1951, therefore they will be taken into account in the chapter on projections.

Survival Rates in Montana's Public Schools

The grade one enrolments divided by the number of births six years previous showed what percent of those born entered the first grade.⁵ This was done for the years between 1940 and 1950 and the resulting enrolment-birth ratios were averaged. The survival rate from grade to grade is figured the same way, only for a five year period.⁶ The grade one enrolment in 1945 is divided by the grade two enrolment in 1946. This process is repeated for five years. The percent of survival between the following grades was computed in the same manner, through grade twelve. These data were averaged and used for analysis of holding power and for possible future enrolments. Some Montana counties show either no births by place of occurrence or so few that a survival percentage could not be figured. For these counties, a ten year average of grade one enrolments was used. These counties were: Golden Valley, Judith Basin, Liberty, McCone, Meagher, Petroleum, Powder River, Teton, Treasure, Wheatland, and Wibaux.

County survival rates. Table II shows the survival rates from birth to grade one and from grade to grade by counties. In many counties the birth to grade one survival rate is over 100 percent. This could be caused by migration into the county and the fact that birth data were recorded by place of occurrence.

The survival rates by grades for each county show that some counties gradually declined; while other counties had a gradual increase for a few grades. The more populous counties of the state are the ones which show the greatest increases for the elementary enrolments. There are many counties which show an increase between grades eight and nine. This increase is due partly to the shift from private or parochial elementary schools to the public high schools. Increase in the high school enrolment is very rare and most counties show a decreasing survival rate from grades nine to twelve.

Area survival rates. Table III shows the survival rates by the six economic sub-areas. The county survival rates were averaged by areas. This table shows that the trend is toward stable enrolments in Area 1, while Areas 2 and 3 are gradually decreasing. Some counties may be increasing or decreasing within a particular area as shown in Table II.

Holding Power in the Six Areas

For every one hundred pupils who start school in grade one, how many actually continue on and finally enroll in grade twelve? The grade one to twelve holding power was computed for each area by placing the grade one enrolments on an index of one hundred. The survival rate between grades one and two multiplied by one hundred is the grade two enrolment index. The survival rate for grades two and three multiplied by the grade two enrolment index is the index for grade three. This process was continued for the twelve grades of school as shown in Table IV. In Table V, the holding power for grades nine to twelve was computed by the same process. The holding power for each county could be computed in the same manner.

The holding power for grades one to twelve in each area varied from a high of 72 in Area 1b to a low of 50 in Area 3a. The holding power for grades one to eight throughout the state is generally good probably due to Montana's compulsory education laws. The problem of decreased enrolments, holding power, or drop outs come in the high school. Area 2 was the area with the best holding power for grades nine to twelve with Area 1 and Area 3 holding about the same number through high school. The reasons behind the holding power are not considered in this

study. This problem needs to be studied locally and many factors must be taken into consideration.

Enrolment-birth ratios. Total public school enrolments were compared with the number of children born into the age groups of six to seventeen inclusive. For example, all births from 1913 to 1924 added together and divided into the 1930-1931 enrolment showed 89.3 percent of the births for those years were enrolled in public schools. The percentage for 1935-1936 was 87.1, for 1940-1941 it was 88.4, for 1945-1946 it was 77.4 and for 1950-1951 it was 82.7.

Table I shows that the public school enrolments declined between 1930 and 1940 but the enrolment-birth ratio climbed steadily. Between the years 1940 and 1945, the years of World War II, the population of Montana decreased, and both the public school enrolments and the enrolment-birth ratio decreased sharply; between 1945 and 1950 they both increased. The estimated future enrolments are studied in detail in Chapter III.

CHAPTER III

ESTIMATED PUBLIC SCHOOL ENROLMENTS

1951-1952 TO 1959-1960

What is the future for Montana's public school enrolments? The sources of information used for prediction as to future enrolments were birth data and past survival rates from grade to grade. The survival rates have been shown in Chapter II.

Montana's birth rate has fluctuated from time to time. The reasons behind this fluctuation are important. The trend of the birth rate in the United States has been downward since 1800.¹

The prevailing opinion among population specialists seems to be that despite the increase in birth rate during the war period and immediately thereafter, there will shortly be a decline and that the future population in the United States will be characterized by three trends as follows:

1. A continuous decrease in the rate of population increase by decades. Between 1860 and 1940 the percent of population increase by decades declined from 35.6 to 7.2.

2. A gradual reduction in the percent of the total population found in the 5-to-19-year old group, the group from which public-school enrolment is largely drawn.

3. A rather sharp increase in the proportion of the total population in the 65-and-over age group.²

The birth rates for Montana are shown in Table VI along with the birth totals. From this it can be seen that Montana's birth rate has fallen and risen for different periods of time. Since 1946, Montana's birth totals have risen steadily and in 1950 the state recorded 15,592 births. Those children born in 1946 will be eligible to enter school in 1952-1953; therefore it is expected that that particular group will be the first of several large groups to enter the first grade and continue on from grade to grade, increasing the enrolment totals. One high year will not show up as outstanding because of the fact that those children may move before they enter school.

The years of 1946 through 1950 have been years with high birth totals. Children born in these years should be in grades one through five in the year 1956-1957. This is the largest group of births Montana has ever had. The large group of children born in 1946-1950 will be in grades seven through twelve in the school year 1963-1964. After this group has graduated from high school, if there is a decline in the annual number of births in the state, there may be a decrease in the need for expansion of educational facilities. However, some areas may need new buildings or classrooms to replace old ones or to meet the need of

heavier enrolments in centers of population. These factors will have to be studied at the local level to determine exactly what may be needed in the way of buildings. Buildings are very costly and can not be built to house one group of children unless the enrolment seems to indicate that it will continue to be large. Careful long term planning is needed.

Recorded Birth Data

The birth data have always been recorded by place of occurrence until 1946 when the system was changed to include both place of occurrence and residence of mother. The recording by occurrence is inadequate since these data will not show in what county children will reside. For example, many people from surrounding counties come to Missoula for hospital facilities. Therefore, before 1946, if a child was born in Missoula it was recorded as a Missoula birth even if the parents moved the child home to a neighboring county. This same situation exists in the area surrounding many of the other large cities such as Great Falls and Billings. Birth data according to place of occurrence were used throughout this study because they have been recorded in this same manner for the entire period of this study.

Projection

Table II shows the percentage of the children born in each county that actually enrolled in grade one, six years later. This percentage was applied to each birth group for the years 1945 through 1950. These are, then, the possible first grade enrolments for the school years 1952 through 1957. The same percentage was applied to the estimated number of births for the years 1951 to 1953 to determine estimated grade one enrolments for the school years 1958 through 1960. The grade one average for ten years, for a few counties listed in Chapter II, was used rather than percentage of grade one enrolments to births. The percentage of survival rates as described in Chapter II between each grade was applied to get estimates for the years ahead. Therefore, the known survival rates were applied to the number of children already enrolled in school. Most of those children in grade one in 1950-1951 will be in grade two in 1951-1952; those in grade two in 1950-1951 will be in grade three in 1951-1952; etc. Most of those in grade one in 1950-1951 will be in grade ten in 1959-1960. Therefore, most of the projections were computed on the number of children actually enrolled in school. The relatively large group of children born between 1946 and 1950 will be in grades four to eight in 1959-1960. This group of children may cause crowded conditions in some counties of Montana

or in certain localities within the counties. If the birth rate should continue to be high Montana's public school enrolments will continue to grow. These projection data for each county are shown in the appendices for the school years 1951-1952 through 1959-1960. The totals of grades one to eight and nine to twelve are given for each county.

Area and State Projection Totals

The projection shows Montana with a public school enrolment of 143,899 in 1960 as compared with a previous high of 120,385 in 1930. Montana's population may reach 578,000 in 1960. This is a high estimate.⁴ This is an early release and later estimates will be broken down by economic areas for the state.

The area totals for grades one to eight and nine to twelve for the years 1952 to 1960 are shown in Table VII. If Table II is compared with Table VII it can be seen that some significant changes are taking place in Montana's school population. These changes are due to the concentration of population in certain areas of the state, hence the concentration of births. In the 1950 enrolments for grades one to eight in Area 1 had surpassed the peak enrolment of 1931. This area should continue to gain throughout 1951 to 1960, and will be the area with the largest enrol-

ment. This indicates that within this area crowded conditions may exist at least through 1960 in grades one to eight. The high school enrolment for Area 1 was higher in 1950 than it was in 1931 and will continue to increase from 1951 through 1959. This area will possibly have a slight decline in 1960. This decline will not continue because high elementary enrolments will be coming into the high school. The large group of children born between 1946 and 1950 should be in grades nine to twelve in 1963-1964.

Area 2 has declined more rapidly than any other area and any increase will probably be slower than the other areas for grades one to eight. The predicted total for 1960 is still below the 1931 level. Area 2 will increase slightly in high school enrolments to 1960.

The projection for Area 3 shows a slight increase in 1960 over the 1931 grade one to eight peak. This is not a rapidly growing area. Local situations may vary from this particular projection and will have to be taken into account in that locality. The high school enrolment will increase slightly by 1960 but not a great deal over the previous high school enrolment peak in 1935 for that area. The increase after 1960 will be slight due to the small increase in elementary enrolments.

From Table VII, it can be seen that the state of Montana will have a higher public school enrolment in 1955 than it had in 1931. In the following years it is possible

that this enrolment will continue to increase with a total public school enrolment of 143,899 in 1960.

The 1955-1956 and 1959-1960 estimated totals were checked by the method described in Chapter II, percent of births to the total enrolment. The estimated public school enrolment for 1955-1956 was found to be 127,512. The corresponding birth totals from 1938 to 1947 inclusive totaled 146,347. Dividing the estimated enrolment by the number of births shows an enrolment-birth ratio of 87.1 percent. The enrolment-birth ratio for 1959-1960 is 87.8 percent. The births for 1951 to 1953 were estimated at 15,500. These enrolment-birth ratios computed on the estimates for 1955 and 1960 may be compared with the ratio in 1930 of 89.3 percent; 1935, 87.1 percent; 1940, 83.4 percent; and 1950, 82.7 percent. The enrolment-birth ratio found for the estimated future enrolments is much better than the low in 1945-1946 of 77.3 percent.

The national outlook toward future school enrolments is stated as follows:

1. That on the basis of actual births which have already taken place since 1940 and those which will occur before the current birth rate declines to any appreciable extent, there will be at least 5,000,000 more children to accommodate in the decade 1950 to 1960 than at the beginning of World War II.

2. That even tho these children represent a temporary increase in total school enrolment, they are with us now and, therefore, are entitled to the very best buildings and equipment this nation can provide.

In other words, they should not be penalized because they are a part of a total enrolment which is expected to decline after the next fifteen or twenty years.⁵

Montana educators should consider these points when planning for the education of the children in the state. Local situations may vary; however, the trend is obvious and it will certainly affect the state as a whole.

CHAPTER IV

SUMMARY

The use of economic areas made it possible to show where the concentrations in population have been in Montana. The western area of the state, which is Economic Area 1, has had the largest population. The trend shown in the prediction seems to indicate that this area will continue to grow quite rapidly for some time. The northern and western section of the state, Area 2, will probably not have an appreciable school population increase in the next few years. The southern and eastern section of the state, Area 3, will possibly have a heavier increase in population than Area 2 but still not as large as Area 1. These changes in school population indicate that in some sections of the state there may be crowded conditions within the schools while in other sections the school population will decline rapidly. Many school districts may even be abandoned or consolidated in order to maintain schools.

Montana's public schools are not holding all pupils through twelve grades of school. The reasons behind this have not been taken into consideration. Table IV shows the holding power of grades one to twelve while Table V shows the holding power of grades nine to twelve. If a county or

chool district is taken separately it may have a higher or lower percent of holding power. Montana ranks sixteenth among the states as to the number of children of school age and those actually enrolled in school.¹ The decrease in enrolment comes in grades ten through twelve. This sudden drop or continued drop may be due to the compulsory attendance law of this state, and it may be due to several other factors which were not taken into account. The holding power for each area as shown in Tables IV and V, can be studied to see their particular patterns. The percent that the total enrolment is of the corresponding births shows that Montana had higher enrolment-birth ratios in 1930, 1935, and 1940 than in 1945 and 1950. These ratios were rising in 1950 and if this continues may reach the 1940 ratio of 88.4 percent.

In a few years it will be possible to make projections on the basis of births by residence which will be more accurate. If the data were made available in school censuses by one year age groups these data could also be used.

Despite the current survival rates Montana's public school enrolments are increasing. These increases are gradual and will be approximately 38,000 higher in 1960 than they were in 1950. If the younger parents remain in

e state this estimate of total public school enrolments 143,899 is not at all improbable. These projection data counties should be checked against the actual totals. they prove to be a reasonable projection, follow-up studies can be done in the same manner with a good assurance accuracy under normal circumstances. It was not possible foresee any events which may disrupt an apparently normal pattern.

Past enrolments and birth data can be used to predict future school enrolments at the local level as easily at the state or county level. This study should give suggestions or ideas as to what procedures can be used in estimating future enrolments. If a study were done at the local level many other factors should be taken into consideration such as the industrial and cultural characteristics of the community. Such a study is essential to planning a local educational program.
