Dr. Albert A. Helbing, acting dean of the Montana State University School of Business Administration, has accepted a two year appointment to the staff of the University of Indonesia at Jakarta, he announced this week.

In his new assignment, Dr. Helbing will serve as a research economist under a Ford Foundation grant administered by the University of California. He will also teach at the graduate and undergraduate levels in the field of management, in which he has specialized as an MSU professor and corporation consultant.

Prior to his departure for the far east, he will spend the month of

August at Denver University as member of a conference panel on personnel

management and human relations, arranged by the Carnegie Institute of Technology.

Dr. and Mrs. Helbing have been residents of Missoula since the fall of 1948 when he joined the MSU faculty. They will leave San Francisco by plane on Sept. 4, flying via Tokyo and Singapore to Jakarta. They expect to return to Missoula at the conclusion of Dr. Helbing's Indonesian assignment.
