MISSOULA---Montana University basketballers have 22 games on the slate for next season, with the possibility that two or three more contests will be added later, commented Montana Athletic Director Jiggs Dahlberg in releasing the 1960-61 basketball schedule.

Montana resumes cage rivalry with Idaho State University next season, playing the Bengals a home-away series in December. The Grizzlies have met ISC once previously in the past 10 years, losing a contest to the Bengals in the 1952 season.

Two other new teams will make appearances in Missoula next season. They are North Dakota University and South Dakota State. Foes from 1959-60 who will not appear on the Grizzly schedule next winter are Nebraska, Oregon State and Washington State.

New Mexico at Albuquerque Feb. 16, Denver at Denver Feb. 18, Utah State at Missoula Feb. 23, Brigham Young at Missoula Feb. 25, Colorado State at Ft. Collins March 3, and Wyoming at Laramie March 4.
