Kenneth W. Koenig, a Montana State University senior majoring in foreign languages, is the University's selection as candidate for a Rhodes Scholarship, it was announced by Dr. Melvin Wren, chairman of the MSU Rhodes committee.

Koenig, the son of Walter A. Koenig, 2117 3rd Ave. S., Great Falls, will be examined by the state Rhodes committee sometime in December, Dr. Wren said. A student who receives a Rhodes appointment is entitled to two years of study at Oxford University.
