Dr. John L. Wailes, Montana State University pharmacy professor, has received a continuation grant of \$4,219 from the U. S. Public Health Service to support his research on preservatives on mold respiration, according to Dean R. L. Van Horne.

The MSU pharmacist is seeking a method of testing preservatives in pharmaceutical products that would save time in the manufacturing process. He has been working on the project, with USPHS support, since 1959.
