A total of 450 young men and their advisers have registered for the DeMolay conclave being held on the University of Montana campus through Sunday.

Conclave activities got under way Thursday. UM president Robert T. Pantzer and Richard Shoup, Missoula mayor, address<sup>sed</sup> conclave participants Friday.

Saturday morning's activities will include election of state officers for the coming year and selection of next year's conclave site.

There will be a presentation of awards and a closing ceremony at 4 p.m. Saturday in the UM Music Recital Hall. A banquet with installation of the new officers followed by the Grand Ball and the crowning of the 1968 State Sweetheart will close conclave activities Saturday evening.
