Preparations are under way for student registration at the University of Montana. About 7,575 students are expected to enroll for fall quarter.

Freshmen, including transfer freshmen, will register from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Thursday (Sept 25) in the Harry Adams Field House, according to the alphabetical distribution listed in the directions for registration in the class schedule.

Former students and new transfers will register from 3-5 p.m. Thursday (Sept. 25) and 8 a.m.-noon and 1-5 p.m. Friday (Sept. 26), according to the directions in the class schedule.

Returning students may pick up their registration packets from 8:30 a.m.-noon and 1-5 p.m. on Monday (Sept. 22), and from 8 a.m.-noon and 1-5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday (Sept. 23-26) in Main Hall Auditorium, room 205. Classes begin Monday (Sept 29).

Freshmen, including transfer freshmen, will receive their registration packets at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday (Sept. 24) in rooms which have been assigned to them. During the same day, freshmen will receive additional registration instructions and will meet with their advisers in groups.

Upperclassmen who are transfers will receive their packets at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday (Sept. 24) in assigned rooms.

They will meet with their advisers at 3 p.m. the same day.

Upon receiving their packets, students should go to the Territorial Rooms in the Lodge to have their identification-card pictures taken. Pictures will be taken Monday through Friday (Sept. 22-26). They will be laminated with plastic on the new I.D. cards required of all students for fall registration. Students will receive their I.D. cards immediately after photos are taken.
