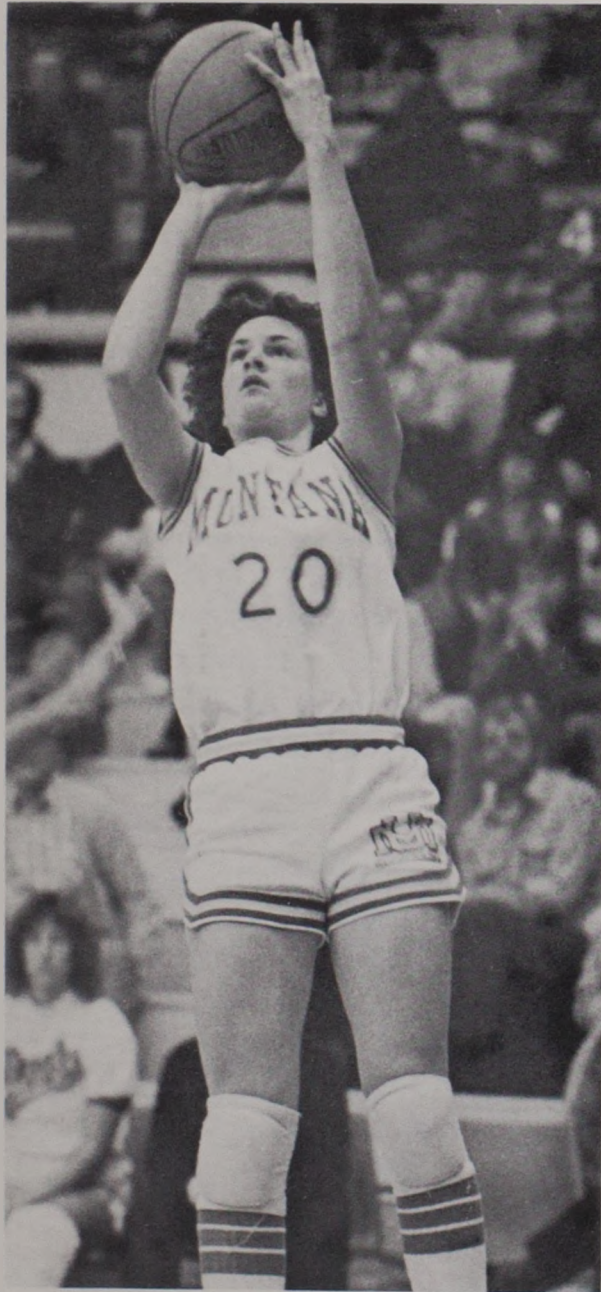

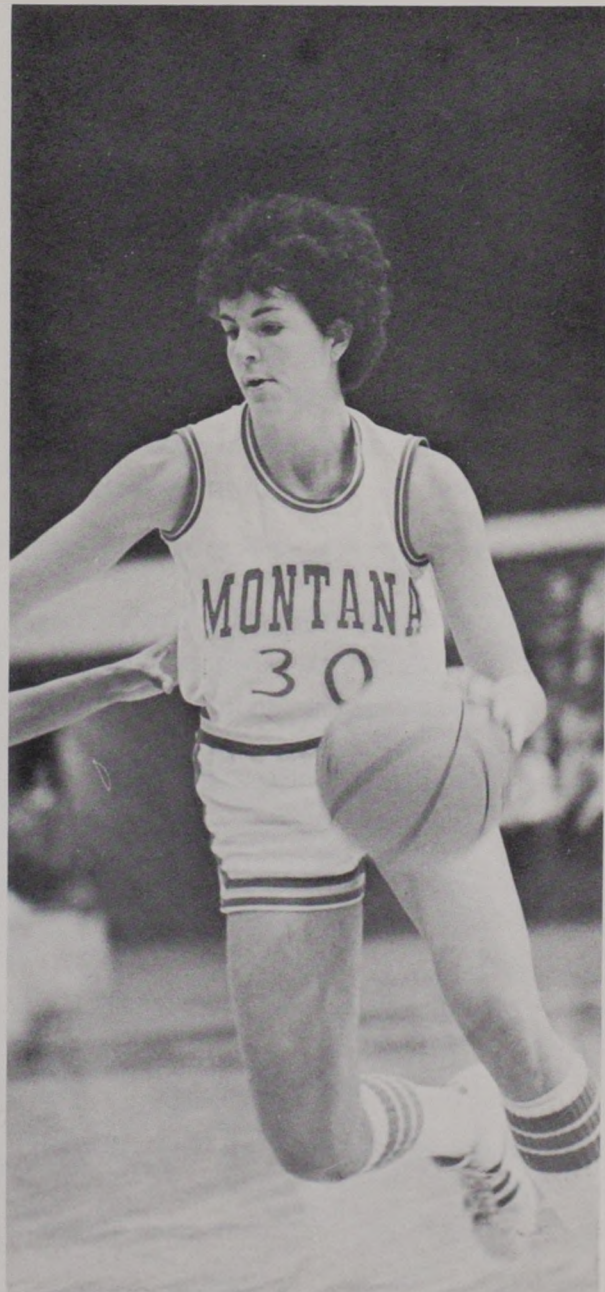

Juli Eckmann . . . 5-11 . . . junior . . . guard-forward . . . Magic City Campus, Minot, ND . . . 1979 North Dakota Female Athlete of the Year . . . came off the bench to spark several comebacks last year.

Ruth Fugelberg . . . 5-8 . . . junior . . . guard-forward . . . Polson, MT High School . . . transfer from Boise State . . . second-team all-conference selection in 1979-80 . . . good shooting touch . . . good rebounder for her size.

Sue Habbe . . . 5-8 . . . junior . . . guard-forward . . . Hellgate High School, Missoula, MT . . . played basketball, track and golf in high school . . . dedicated worker . . . good outside shooter.

Janet Ruetten . . . 5-9½ . . . junior . . . forward . . . Patrick Henry High School, San Diego, CA . . . sixth in the nation in free throw shooting in 1979-80 (85.2%) . . . starter for the first half of last season.

Cathy St. John . . . 5-8 . . . junior . . . guard . . . Opeheim, MT High School . . . very aggressive . . . good defensive player . . . all-conference selection in high school.

Cheri Bratt . . . 5-10½ . . . sophomore . . . guard . . . Flathead High School, Kalispell, MT . . . set UM season records for steals (94) and assists (128) last season . . . honorable-mention all-conference . . . excellent all-around basketball skills.

Doris Deden . . . 6-1½ . . . sophomore . . . center . . . Sentinel High School, Missoula, MT . . . set school record for field goal percentage last season (53.4%) . . . was second on the team in both scoring and rebounding . . . strong inside player.

Siobhan Hathhorn . . . 6-0 . . . sophomore . . . forward . . . Diamond High School, Anchorage, AK . . . transfer from Stanford . . . three-time all-stater in high school . . . Carnation All-American as a senior . . . strong defensive player.

Shari Thesenvitz . . . 6-0 . . . sophomore . . . forward . . . Hanford High School, Richland, WA . . . probably the best returning defensive player . . . all-conference and second-team all-state in high school.

Sheri Henry . . . 6-0 . . . freshman . . . forward . . . Sentinel High School, Missoula, MT . . . three-sport letterwinner . . . all-conference and all-state in basketball.

Barb Kavanaugh . . . 5-9½ . . . freshman . . . guard . . . Rocky Mountain High School, Fort Collins, CO . . . averaged 17 points, eight rebounds and three assists last season . . . all-conference and all-state for two years.

Mary Koehler . . . 5-8½ . . . freshman . . . guard . . . Aberdeen, MD High School . . . averaged 15 points and 10 rebounds last season . . . first-team all-county selection.

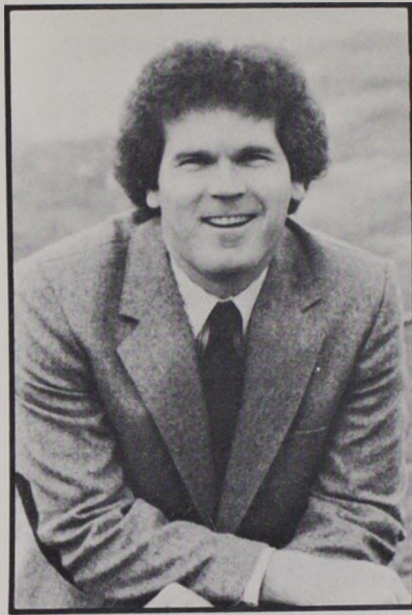

Robin Selvig has compiled an impressive 54-31 record in his three years as head coach of the University of Montana women's basketball team. Last season's 22-8 record was the best in the school's history. A first place finish in the Mountain Division of the Northwest Women's Basketball League earned the team a berth in the playoffs for the third straight year. Selvig's teams have also led the NWBL in team defense the last three years, allowing just 55.5 points per game last year.

Selvig graduated from the University of Montana in 1974, playing four years for the Grizzlies. As a senior, he was a second-team All-Big Sky Conference selection and won the University's top athletic award, the Grizzly Cup. He was named the best defensive player on the UM team that year.

Jill Greenfield is entering her first year as assistant coach of the University of Montana women's basketball team.

Greenfield concluded an outstanding two year career with the Grizzlies last season. She practically rewrote the UM record book, claiming nine season and career records.

Greenfield will be the assistant coach of the varsity squad.
