- a. University Committees- number of different committees across campus, not specific to UMSS
  - i. Many are temporary, but some are standard: Budget, Basic Needs
  - ii. Want to make sure committees have representation from staff
  - iii. Trying to get a list of all the committees on campus- Maggie Angle in Presidents office is working to get a formal list and what their tasks are
- b. Search Committees
  - i. Director of OOLD- approved to move forward with on-campus interviews
  - ii. TRIO director- interviewing four candidates
    - 1. Completed two out of four so far
    - 2. Looking to have them hired and on campus this month (June)
- c. Montana University System Staff Association
  - i. BOR presentation in May
- d. Strategic Enrollment Planning
  - i. Update: over the course of the whole last year- different strategies and proposals brought to committee
  - ii. About improving the student experience
  - iii. A lot of these proposals have proved a return on investment-impact could be substantial

- b. Rundown of UMSS meetings- what they typically look like, when they are, guests, etc.
- c. Any questions?
  - i. Voting- can you vote in advance if not able to attend?
  - ii. Proposals- what kind of proposals are there?
    - 1. Basic overview of shared governance- faculty senate has control over curriculum; ASUM has
    - 2. Power of proposals- basically recommendations
  - iii. Election process:
    - 1. Changed over the years
    - 2. Election window
    - 3. Either nominated or nominated yourself
    - 4. Qualtrics survey sent to all Staff- voting on for your own classification
    - 5. A few years ago, increased cap from 30 to 40- shouldn't be any barriers to being a senator
      - a. Not a competitive process any longer
    - 6. XO elections happen in June meeting
  - iv. What happens when you hit cap?
    - 1. Would need to start designating seats, and making sure there are correct classification amounts on the senate
  - v. Terms?
    - 1. Each term is two years, and then can re-nominate oneself
    - 2. Serve three terms
  - vi. Information from the meetings?
    - 1. Meetings are public- nothing talked about here is prohibited from being heard outside of this meeting
    - 2. Information dissemination is expected from UMSS meetings to departments- if pertain to campus as a whole
      - a. Hard thing to enforce
    - 3. Restrictions on what sort of mass emails can be sent to the whole campus
      - a. Mostly 'Care Share' requests & notices about elections
  - vii. Committees & committee assignments
    - 1. Five committees- senators are required to be part of at least one
    - 2. Scholarship- we have a scholarship we give out to dependents on campus; committee is responsible for getting funds and choosing winner
    - 3. Bylaws- adjusting bylaws as needed, or giving info on bylaws when needed
    - 4. CVC- dedicated to managing website, organizing events (fire pit gatherings, pint nights)
    - 5. Data- responsible for generating and evaluating different surveys we send out
    - 6. Professional Development- address different professional development opportunities on campus; works closely with OOLD
    - 7. Will be decided in July
  - viii. Shared Governance meetings?
    - 1. XOs from each governance meets a few times
    - 2. Has representation on Cabinet
    - 3. Sometimes leaders will present at UMSS meetings
  - ix. Outreach with unions?



- 1. Violet Hopkins is the President of MFPE- regularly in XO meetings and shared governance meetings
- 2. Other reps-don't have as much communication with
- 3. Proposals that were presented with BOR were shared with Union reps
- 4. Carson-going into legislation year and will be advocating with for what we need

#### 5. Executive Officer Elections

    - 1. Duties: management and operations of the budget (2 indices)

  - iii. Vice Chair- takes over as chair; great opportunity to be a part of the larger university; a larger time commitment; great opportunity; needs to be at the start of the term but also needs to have one term under belt

#### 6. Board of Regents Recap

- a. Background:
  - i. MUSSA- Montana University System Staff Association: representation of 8 institutions
    - 1. Not every institution has a senate
    - 2. Report to the Commissioner and Board of Regents
  - ii. MUSFAR- faculty representation from every institution
  - iii. ASUMS- student association from every institution
  - iv. BOR meetings happen four times a year- when big decisions are made; rotate campuses
- b. MUSSA gets dedicated time with BOR during larger meetings
- c. Schwetferger presented about Staff retention in May
  - i. Helpful that May was focused on staff and raising wages in general
  - ii. There is a commitment to solving these issues swiftly
  - iii. Bring up wages with Cabinet frequently- told wages are a BOR decision
  - iv. There will be a request to increase wages and tuition on campuses
    - 1. Union contracts need to be negotiated- 13 to 15 unions represented across the campus
      - a. MFPE is the largest
