The Faculty met in regular session with all members present except Prof. Scheuch. Prof. Riley was appointed secret. pro. tem.

The Comm. on Grading & Classif. presented a report of work yet to be done by students expecting to graduate this year. - On motion said report was accepted and the recommendation contained therein in regard to Miss Steewles adopted.

M. A. and carried - That the persons whose conditions are stated in the committee's report be allowed to take the number of hours next semester that are stated in said report to be necessary for graduation.

A communication from Mr. Ebert in regard to some foot-ball property was read and on motion referred to the Committee on Athletics with power to act. - After some informal discussion of the financial condition of Athletic Affairs, use of halls, etc. - The meeting adjourned.
