CHERI BRATT

Guard — 5-10
Senior — Kalispell, Montana

The 1982-83 Lady Griz MVP, Bratt averaged 10.8 points, 4.3 rebounds and 4.9 assists a game . . . also led the team in steals (78) and free throw percentage (.798) . . . set single-season assist record with 142 in 1982-83 . . . holds single-season record for steals (94 in 1980-81) . . . first team all-Mountain West Athletic Conference in 1982-83 . . . second team all-Northwest Women's Basketball League (NWBL) in 1981-82 . . . first team

CoSIDA (College Sports Information Directors of America) District 7 all-academic pick in 1981-82 . . . honorable mention all-NWBL in 1980-81 . . . named Outstanding Defensive Player on the team in 1981-82 . . . third in career scoring (818) and sixth in career rebounding (449) . . . probably the team's most complete player . . . three-time all-conference and all-state pick at Flathead High.



MARY KOEHLER

Guard — 5-8½
Sophomore — Aberdeen, Maryland

Koehler returns to the Lady Griz after sitting out the 1982-83 season . . . leading scorer on the 1981-82 JV squad, averaging 14 points a game . . . played in six varsity games that season . . . averaged 0.7 points and 0.5 rebounds . . . good speed and quickness . . . two-time all-county selection at Aberdeen High.



DORIS DEDEN HASQUET

Center — 6-1
Senior — Missoula, Montana

As her senior year approaches, Hasquet is virtually assured of becoming the UM career scoring and rebounding leader . . . only needs 16 points and 19 rebounds to take over first place in those categories . . . 918 points and 608 rebounds after her junior season . . . averaged 8.4 points and 6.9 rebounds last season . . . set a single-season blocked shot record with 41 in 1982-83 . . . 1981-82 MVP . . . averaged 13.9 points and 7.1 rebounds in that season . . .

second team all-NWBL and first team CoSIDA District 7 all-academic in 1981-82 . . . holds single-season field goal percentage record (.534 in 1980-81) . . . all-state pick at Sentinel High.



SHARLA MURALT

Center — 6-1
Sophomore — Missoula, Montana

One of the top reserves last season, Muralt gives the team extra scoring and rebounding punch on the inside . . . averaged 5 points and 4.9 rebounds . . . scored 15 points and pulled down 17 rebounds in leading the Lady Griz to a 72-57 win over BYU . . . led Sentinel High to a second-place finish in the state Class AA Tournament as a senior . . . two-time all-state and all-conference pick . . . Converse High School All-American her senior year.



BARB KAVANAGH

Guard — 5-9½
Junior — Fort Collins, Colorado

After starting as a freshman, Kavanagh suffered through an injury-plagued sophomore season . . . played well during pre-season drills and appears to be back to full strength . . . averaged 3 points and 1 rebound last season . . . 1982-83 Shannon Green Inspirational Award winner . . . averaged 8.5 points, 2.4 rebounds and 3.7 assists her freshman year . . . also led the team in free throw percentage (.784) as a freshman . . .

very steady player . . . two-time all-conference and all-state selection at Rocky Mountain High.



MARGARET WILLIAMS

Guard — 5-8
Sophomore — Olympia, Washington

Williams has added a whole new dimension to the Lady Griz because of her outstanding speed and quickness . . . often the first player off the bench late last season . . . averaged 4.1 points, 2 assists and 1.2 rebounds . . . excellent lead guard skills . . . good outside shooting touch . . . Player of the Year in the Black Hills League her junior and senior years at Olympia High.



ANITA NOVAK

Forward — 6-2½
Junior — Minot, North Dakota

Novak started at the big forward spot last season, but she also has the ability to play center . . . third-leading scorer (9.4 ppg) and leading rebounder (7.2 rpg) on the team in 1982-83 . . . scored a team single-game high of 25 points against Montana Tech last year . . . eighth in career rebounding with 355 boards . . . nice outside shooting touch and good mobility for her size . . . one of the most highly sought-after athletes in North Dakota history . . .

two-time all-state and all-conference choice at Magic City Campus . . . Converse High School All-American as a senior.



STACEY EDWARDS

Forward — 5-11
Freshman — Highland Parks, Illinois

The 1983 Northern Chicago Suburbs Player of the Year, Edwards averaged 21 points, 10 rebounds and 3.5 assists a game . . . hit on 56 percent of her field goal attempts and 84 percent of her free throws . . . three-time first team all-conference and all-county selection . . . honorable mention all-state pick in 1982-83 . . . captained the basketball, volleyball and softball teams at Deerfield High.

CINDY MUCHMORE

Guard — 5-7

Freshman — Mannheim, Germany

Muchmore averaged 23.4 points, 9.1 rebounds and 3.1 assists as a senior at Mannheim High . . . first team all-tour pick her junior and senior years . . . spent her junior year at Incirlik High in Turkey . . . also lettered in soccer, volleyball and track in high school.



NATALIE STREETER

Guard — 5-9

Freshman — Great Falls, Montana

Streeter has been a member of three straight undefeated state Class AA championship teams at Great Falls High . . . never lost a game in her varsity career . . . averaged 18.5 points, 8.4 rebounds, 5.5 steals and 3.6 assists as a senior . . . first team all-state, all-conference, all-state tournament and all-divisional tournament last season . . . won the 1983 Little Sullivan Award which is presented to Montana's top female amateur athlete . . .

Converse High School All-American last season . . . versatile player who can play anywhere from point guard to small forward.



MO PATRICK

Forward — 5-10½

Freshman — Darby, Montana

A Class B all-state pick, Patrick averaged 20 points and 10 rebounds last season at Darby . . . all-conference for three seasons . . . honorable mention Converse High School All-American in 1982-83 . . . 1982 Grizzly Cage Camp Award recipient . . . strong player . . . good scorer.



LAURIE STRUBE

Center — 6-2

Freshman — Minot, North Dakota

The third Magic City Campus product to come to UM in the last five years (along with Novak and the recently graduated Juli Eckmann), Strube averaged 14 points and 9 rebounds her senior year . . . connected on 68.5 percent of her field goal attempts last season . . . 1982 all-conference selection . . . played in the North Dakota Class A All-Star Game . . . good speed . . . nice shooting touch.

The Coaches



Robin Selvig
Head Coach

Robin Selvig took over a struggling University of Montana women's basketball program in 1978 and immediately turned it around. He is the only basketball coach (men's or women's) in the school's history to win 100 games in his first five seasons.

Selvig's career record is 102-40 and his winning percentage (.718) is also the best of any UM basketball coach ever. The 1982-83 squad's record of 26-4 is the best in the program's history.

Selvig has been named conference Coach of the Year each of the last two seasons. He was also a finalist for national Coach of the Year honors in 1983.

The emphasis is on defense on Selvig's teams. The Lady Griz led the nation in scoring defense in 1981-82, allowing just 53.5 points a game. UM was third in scoring defense (55.0 ppg) and fifth in field goal percentage defense (.380) last season.

Before taking over the lady Griz basketball program, Selvig was the head girls' basketball coach at Plentywood High School from 1975 to 1978.



Annette Whitaker
Assistant Coach

Annette Whitaker became the first full-time assistant women's basketball coach at UM in September, 1983.

Whitaker served as graduate assistant coach at Montana for two seasons before assuming her new post. She assists Selvig in all phases of coaching.

Annette was a two-year starter at the guard position for the Lady Griz before joining the coaching ranks.

She received a bachelor's degree in health and physical education from UM in 1982 and has been working on her master's degree in HPE.
