WRITING COURSE FOR ELEMENTARY TEACHERS RE-SCHEDULED BY UNIVERSITY

A University of Montana course designed to improve skills in teaching writing in elementary school has been rescheduled to start Jan. 23. The class will meet in the library at Lewis and Clark Elementary School on Wednesdays from 4 to 7 p.m. through March 27.

Margaret Grant of the Lewis and Clark faculty will teach the course, which will stress the translation of research findings into classroom practice.
