ORDERS OF THE DAY

To: All students and members of the faculty and associated personnel.

Subject: Assignments and schedule for Aber Day.

Reveille at 0700 (7:00 a.m.). All personnel will report for assignment tasks by 0800 (8:00 a.m.). Voting polls open at 1000 (10 a.m.) and close at 1200 (12 noon). Candidates will stay at Memorial Row until 1200. Mess call is designated for 1300 (1 p.m.) at Natural Science Barracks. Summary court will take place at 1415 (2:15 p.m.) in front of the library hut. A blitzkreig dance begins at 2000 (8:00 p.m.) in the service club at Gold Room Headquarters of the Student Union. Taps at 2330 (11:30 p.m.).

Personnel will report to the place of their assigned tasks at the assigned time. All furloughs and passes will be cancelled unless duty is performed to satisfaction of platoon commanders. Failure to do duty satisfactorily will subject all personnel to a summary courts martial. Any case of A.W.O.L. from the post area will be punished by the trial judge advocate.

Dress for the day: fatigues. Post personnel will report in bivouac dress. Bodily adornments which hamper the reaching of the desired objective will not be permitted, such as lipstick, bandanas and ties.
