UM OFFERS EVENING HISTORY COURSE IN HAMILTON

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana will give a course on "The 1960s" at Hamilton High School from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. on Tuesdays from March 26 through May 28.

Robert L. Peterson, UM history professor, will teach the course, which will survey the political, economic, social and military history of the 1960s. It will emphasize the presidential elections of the decade, Keynesian and neo-Keynesian postures, the counter-culture and student movements, civil rights struggles and the Vietnam War.

The course offers 3 undergraduate or graduate credits. The cost is \$90. Pre-registration and payment of fees are required by March 22.
