UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA WILL CONDUCT
ARTHRITIS SEMINAR IN BILLINGS

MISSOULA--

A seminar on arthritis will be given by the University of Montana School of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences Saturday, March 30, in Billings.

The seminar will meet from 8:30 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. in Library 152 at Eastern Montana College.

Local physical therapists and two UM pharmacy professors, Gayle A. Cochran and Michael P. Rivey, will conduct the seminar. They will review the pathophysiology, symptomatology and current therapies of arthritis and will describe the impact of physical therapy and new drug developments on the care of the arthritic patient.

The seminar is approved for six hours of continuing education credit (0.6 CEU). The fee is \$45 at the door or \$35 paid 10 days in advance.
