



Montana University System students are invited to take part in a new study abroad experience, the *Roma Storytelling Project*, tentatively slated for May 4-18, 2023.

NOTE: UM students will need to directly apply to MSU-Billings to earn academic credit for this experience.

The objectives are to identify barriers to human rights and stories of triumph expressed by Roma people living in Macedonia.

The partner university, [South East European University](#) in Tetovo, Macedonia, has agreed to host our students for this unique project. Contact with Roma participants will be facilitated through the EU RoMigSc project, an NGO working on educational opportunities for Roma children.
