

ISEP Study Abroad Info Session




EA will be hosting a study abroad information session with ISEP representative Daniel Watson, on <u>Thursday October 5th from 12–1 in UC 333</u>.




The President's Lecture Series Presents: "Braiding Sweetgrass: Indigenous Wisdom, Scientific Knowledge and the Teaching of Plants"
