Course purpose is to provide an introductory graduate survey of international relations literature.

Course objective: Upon successful completion of this course, the student should be able to demonstrate 1) M.A.-level knowledge of international relations literature, 2) an advanced understanding of international politics, law and organization and 3) pre-professional oral and written communication skills.

1. Basic reading for the course will be assigned from the bibliography provided in class. Book reviews should be written according to the format provided in class. Specific book assignments and due dates will be listed on a matrix provided in class. Late written assignments will **NOT** BE GRADED!

2. Grades will be based upon written book reviews (60%) and oral presentation and discussion (40%) of each assigned book. Regular attendance and active participation are presumed in a graduate seminar.
