9 Whereas Article 25 Section 2 of The Associated Students of The University of Montana
10 (ASUM) Fiscal Policy states, “After expense forms have been approved by the ASUM
11 Elections Committee, ASUM will match 50% of candidate expenditures with receipts in
12 the form of a reimbursement;”

13
14 Whereas Article 5 “Elections” Section H.4 of the ASUM Bylaws states, “Candidates may
15 choose to be reimbursed for campaigning expenditures to the amount of \$10, dependent
16 upon receipts following the General Elections. Expenditures exceeding \$10 will be
17 matched 50% by ASUM. Total ASUM contributions shall not exceed \$37.50 for Senate
18 candidates, \$50 for Business manager candidates and \$75 for President/Vice President
19 candidates. All claimed expenditures for reimbursement must have receipts. Expenditures
20 without receipts will not be matched by ASUM;”

22 Whereas Article 25 Section 2 of ASUM Fiscal Policy and Article 5 Section H.4 of the
23 ASUM Bylaws are not in agreement.

25 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved that Article 25 Section 2 ASUM Fiscal Policy is amended
26 to state:

28 “Candidates may choose to be reimbursed for campaigning expenditures to the
29 amount of \$10, dependent upon receipts following the General Elections.
30 Expenditures exceeding \$10 will be matched 50% by ASUM. Total ASUM
31 contributions shall not exceed \$37.50 for Senate candidates, \$50 for Business
32 manager candidates and \$75 for President/Vice President candidates. All claimed
33 expenditures for reimbursement must have receipts. Expenditures without receipts
34 will not be matched by ASUM.”
