President's Office.

October 11<sup>th</sup> 95.

Meeting called at 3 p.m. by Pres. Craig. Miss Gray absent. Reading of minutes dispensed with. Dr. Craig reads invitations to the Faculty by the ladies of Missoula for a reception tendered to the Faculty of the University for Friday eve. Oct 12<sup>th</sup> - also reads answer to the same. Under 1<sup>st</sup> order of business Prof. Aber makes his report regarding Rev. Dr. Steward. Report is accepted and the Secretary instructed to send same to the gentlemen named. Moved that the change in work of students be made in view of a 3 years course in the Preparatory and that this be discussed at the next meeting Thursday Oct 18<sup>th</sup>. Discussion on this subject. Several names were read by Profs. Aber and Keiley for the consideration of the Faculty. - Discussion on the matter left for decision at next meeting. - Oct 17<sup>th</sup>. After which adjourned.

# 8.

October 18<sup>th</sup> 1895.

Irregular students

Meeting was called to order by Pres. Craig at 3 p.m. All members present - Dispensed with the reading of minutes before passing to the regular business. Rev. T. G. Steward's case was discussed. - Suggested by the president that we look toward the Class system. i.e. dividing the Preparatory into First & 2<sup>d</sup> and those students who do not full amount of work should be classified as irregular students.

Discussion by members. - Under regular business the roll of students was read, each name discussed separately, changes recommended by members and students reclassified. - Meeting was then adjourned to meet again at 7<sup>30</sup> p.m. at which time the roll of students was continued and changes in studies recommended and made. Adjourned.
