8 Whereas, The Montana Board of Regents has formally endorsed The Smart Buildings Initiative
9 as an official Montana University System priority;

11 Whereas, increased investments in energy efficiency projects could ultimately save Montana
12 campuses millions of dollars;

14 Whereas, real-time energy monitoring equipment is necessary infrastructure for successful and
15 transparent energy efficiency projects;

17 Whereas, real-time energy-use data is vital to facilitating the proper management of heating and
18 cooling systems, allowing managers to make buildings more comfortable for occupants year-
19 round;

21 Whereas, Montana State University-Bozeman and University of Montana-Missoula facilities
22 departments have made investments in real-time energy monitoring equipment a top priority over
23 the past year;
