Association. Report by Pres't Craig on the Halloween crowd. - President next speaks of the Teachers Institute which will assemble in the University beginning Monday the 10th and lasting one week. - Mr. Ed. Boos is excused for several absences. -

Meeting called at 3 p.m. by Pres't Craig. All members present. (Dispensed with) Reading of minutes of previous meeting and adopted. - Petition signed by 10 young men for a literary society was read and granted. - Pres't Craig asks for reports from the Professors on the work that has been done in their respective departments, these reports to be handed in before Thanksgiving vacation, to be used in the annual Pres't report to the Board of Education. Prof. Aber reads names of delinquents in the 1st Prop'y Latin class. Discussion. - Decided to revise the list and classification of students during or soon after Thanksgiving vacation. - Mr. Hoblitzell suspended for 3 unexcused absences. Messrs. Waller Henke and Harry Amisana suspended for the same reason. - Committee consisting of Profs. Merrill, Reiley and Schuch appointed to arrange length and time for periods in Laboratory work. -
