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Objective: To create patterns through the flat patterning and drafting methods.

We will produce patterns through the process of analyzing style lines and details and then translating the information into a finished pattern using both flat pattern and drafting methods. The patterns will then be cut into muslin and tried onto a half scale dress form. Once the skill level of pattern confidence is reached, we will produce slopers for ourselves that will be production ready. You will be a pattern maker when you leave finish this course.

Attendance is a must. This class will move as a whole. We will work by ourselves and as a group.

Grading will be based on completion of the projects, effort put forth, cooperation in class, and the fearlessness to try new things.

Most all materials will be supplied. We will throw a few dollars in the pot to buy paper and tape.

Most of all, let's have fun. Patterning is a great art and there are lost of ways to enjoy the process. With the basic skills you will learn in this course, you will become a pattern maker!
