9   Whereas, The Associated Students of The University of Montana (ASUM) Senate currently  
10 consists of 26 senators;

12   Whereas, ASUM currently has a committee structure composed of 23 committees;

14   Whereas, ASUM senators are not compensated for the time they commit to the organization;

16   Whereas, committees require a considerable time commitment by their members;

18   Whereas, there currently exist at least three university committees addressing issues related to  
19 information technology;

21   Whereas, ASUM contracts its information technology services outside of the organization;

23   Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that ASUM no longer recognize or maintain an information  
24 technology committee as currently mandated by the ASUM bylaws;

26   Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, that Article IV section 11 be removed from the ASUM  
27 bylaws, and that the numbering of the bylaws be changed to reflect this removal.
