THE INDO-CHINA WAR

Mr. President:

I should like to call to the attention of the Senate a series of articles carried in the Washington <sup>Star</sup> Post relative to the war in Indo-China. I do not know all the reporters who wrote these stories but I am well acquainted with Larry Allen who has been in Indo-China for the past three years covering that almost forgotten war for the Associated Press.

Larry Allen is one of the world's best known foreign correspondents and is the only American who has continually been in Indo-China during the past three years to observe conditions in that struggle at first hand.
