8       Whereas, The Associated Student of The University of Montana (ASUM) is the organization  
9       entrusted with representing the student voice;

10  
11       Whereas, the larger campus body is adequately represented by the diversity of the senate body;

12  
13       Whereas, Missoula College and graduate students have a smaller representative body and have  
14       traditionally found it difficult to be elected at-large;

15  
16       Whereas, The Missoula College and Graduate students are historically underrepresented on the  
17       body of senate;

18  
19       Whereas, a reserved senate seat for both The Missoula College and any Graduate student  
20       constituency would help to ensure the voices of under-represented students;

21  
22       Therefore, Let It Be Resolved that if the following language passes a vote of the student body  
23       one senate seat will be held for one Missoula College and one graduate student, if more than one  
24       candidate runs, the person with the highest vote count will win the reserved seat and the runner  
25       up will enter the at-large pool of candidates. If no student from the organization runs, those  
26       organizations' reserved seats will be given back to the at-large pool of student candidates.

28       Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved that the following language be submitted to the April 2013  
29       elections:

31       “The Associated Students of The University of Montana (ASUM), having twenty six senate seats  
32       available to the student body, ASUM proposes reserving two of these seats for one representative  
33       from The Missoula College and one representative from The Graduate School, the remaining to  
34       be voted upon at-large.

36       Do you support the reservation of two senate seats for representatives from The Missoula  
37       College and The Graduate School?

38  
39       Yes, I support the reservation of two senate seats for representatives from both The Missoula  
40       College and The Graduate School.

42       No, I do not support the reservation of two senate seats for representatives from both The  
43       Missoula College and The Graduate School.”
