8       Whereas, The Associated Students of The University of Montana (ASUM) has a duty to  
9       ensure fair elections;

11       Whereas, in the past there have been ballot referendum that have benefited ASUM and its  
12       agencies;

13  
14       Whereas, it is important for ASUM and its employees to take a neutral stance on ballot  
15       referendum that it has a vested interest in;

16  
17       Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that Article V, Subsection P of ASUM Bylaws be added  
18       that reads:

20               The ASUM Senate shall not campaign for the passage or defeat of a ballot  
21               referendum. Any Senator or member of the Executive Team can only campaign  
22               for the passage or defeat of a ballot referendum as an individual and on a  
23               volunteer basis. Any employee of ASUM may be involved in organization  
24               efforts, but not direct campaigning.
