Prof. Elrod reports that Miss Wilson's course of study had been arranged satisfactorily. - Prof. Aber reports as chairman of the com. to arrange Mr. Ward's course that she was allowed to drop Latin and take Trigonometry. Prof. Smith as chairman of Mr. Allard's case reports progress. Mr. Murray requests the faculty to lay out his course in Literature. - referred to Pres't Craig. - A request handed in by the Charities Society signed by Misses Bellew and E. Knowles to have the

open meeting of the Clarkia Society postponed one
 week. - Moved, 2d. and ^{carried} granted that time be post-
 -poned to March 3^d. - Sedman requests to take Physics.
 Request granted. - Mr. Rittenour requests to be allowed to
 substitute Greek for a junior elective. M. that his
 request be granted. - A request read from the
 following: Ellis Sedman, S. R. Ebert, Percy Reimick
 Reimick, G. A. Steward, Edna Parsons, G. Fairwick ^{3/4}
 Lois Newport to be allowed to take up original work
 in Geometry. - M. 2d. and carried that Mr. Sedman be

 Miss Reley and Prof. Aberk Graham requests to be per-
 mitted to drop Latin as it is not required in the M.E.
 course. - Request granted. - Miss Reynolds asks for an
 extra subject. - Left to a com. of Reley, Aber ^{3/4} & Ebrod.
 Miss E. Knowles reports a conflict between Latin ^{3/4}
 Pol. Economy. - M. 2d. carried that she take Latin outside
 and report to class once a week. - Pixley asks for french
 on Senior year electives - com. appointed Ebrod, Smith ^{3/4}
 Dechuch. with power to act. - Miss Beauchamp asks
 permission to drop Latin. M. 2d. ^{3/4} carried that her request
 be granted. - Miss Mcbracken asks to be allowed to take

Moved 2d. and carried that a com. be appointed to arrange a course and report to the faculty. - Scheuch, Reiley and Smith appointed. After which, adjourned

The minutes of the previous meeting were read, corrected and adopted. Prof. Elrod reports on Mr. Pixley's course of study on acct. of conflicts Mr. P. to take Biology instead of Scienc. French. Prof. Kerr as chairman of committee to arrange a course for Miss M^{rs} Bonnick recommends that she take Physics or Chemistry in addition to her present work. - Miss Reynolds to be allowed to enter the beginning Algebra class on trial.

The chairman of com. to arrange Mr. Blake's course recommends that he take Mechanics, Dynamometers & French High Alg. and Chem. - Prof. Smith recommends that Mr. Blair take Phys. II. Brown. II Chem. I Beginning M. 2d. and carried that Miss E. Knowles be given credit for a semester's work in Mathematics, which was not required of her.

M. that ^{action on} Mr. Ebert's request as passed at last faculty meeting be reconsidered. - M. 2d. and carried that Mr. Ebert be allowed to enter the class in Geometry (original work)

Prof. Smith discusses the work in beginning Physics. - Miss Reiley reports the absence of Miss How wood, from her classes. - Prof. Smith
