8       Whereas, The Associated Students of The University of Montana (ASUM) Bylaws were  
9       amended by student vote to expand the ASUM Senate to 26 senate seats;

11       Whereas, current ASUM Bylaws require a primary election to be held when 40 students  
12       run for Senate seats;

13  
14       Whereas, this requirement is a reflection of numbers no longer relevant;

16       Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that Article V, Section 4, Subsection A, Part 5 of ASUM  
17       Bylaws be amended to read:

19       A primary election shall be held for Senate candidates if there are over fifty-two (52)  
20       individuals seeking office.
