8 Whereas, The Associated Students of The University of Montana (ASUM) recently
9 cancelled the Business Manager Primary;

10 Whereas, future Senates now have the power to cancel their primaries,

11 Whereas, Article V, Section 4, Subsection A, Part 6 of the ASUM Bylaws currently
12 states:

13 6. The ballots for the general elections shall consist of no more than two (2)
14 Executives or Executive teams for each executive position and no more than forty
15 (40) Senate candidates with positions for write-in candidates (with the exception
16 of a tie vote in the primary as per section 5.E of Elections Bylaws).

21 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, Article V, Section 4, Subsection A, Part 6 of the ASUM
22 Bylaws be amended to read:

23 6. The ballots for the general elections shall consist of no more than two (2)
24 Executives or Executive teams for each executive position and no more than ~~forty~~
25 (~~40~~) fifty-two (52) Senate candidates with positions for write-in candidates (with
26 the exception of a tie vote in the primary as per section 5.E of Elections Bylaws).
27 **In the event that the primary is waived, the ballots for the general elections**
28 **shall allow for more than two (2) Executives or Executive teams for each**
29 **executive position and/or Fifty-two (52) Senate candidates to appear on the**
30 **ballot.**
