#### FEDERICO GARCIA LORCA, Playwright and Poet

Federico Garcia Lorca was already known as a brilliant poet and playwright when, at the age of 37, he was killed near his native Granada soon after the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War. Since then his life and personality have become legendary, while he has come to be recognized as a poet of genius and possibly the foremost poetic dramatist of our time. Among his most famous plays are, BLOOD WEDDING, YERMA, DONA ROSITA, ROMANCERO GITANA, and THE HOUSE OF BERNARDA ALBA. His published poems include, SONGS, BOOK OF POEMS and POET IN NEW YORK.
