Discussed Mr. Gil. O'Hayforn's absences. Motion that Mr. O'Hayforn's absences be excused and that he be allowed to enter his classes. - 2d. - Carried.

Mr. Flynn ^{was} reported a suspended student by his own action. (3 unexc. absences)

Motion that he be notified by the President that the faculty think that his excuses are not satisfactory but that he will be allowed to enter his classes on probation. - 2d. - Carried.

The following resolution was read by Prof. Smith.

Resolved:

That the football season must close on Thanksgiving day of each year, except

that a game may be played in Missoula not later than Dec. 25. 1898 with the St. Helena team if arrangements have been made for the game previous to this date.

Resolution adopted on motion.

Miss Edna Greenough files a request to be allowed to drop History, for a time at least.

M. 2d. carried that her request be granted.

Miss Brown requests the privilege of dropping Biology. M. 2d. carried that her request be granted.

Reports and estimates sent for, the same to be handed in to the office by next faculty meeting.

Prof. Gluck reports as chairman of the Band comm. on investigation regarding money collected and distributed by the Band.

Report read. - Moved & carried that the report be adopted. - The Secretary is ^{ordered} notified to notify Mr. Wm. Dickenson, Mr. Gil. Skypson, Mr. Thos. Kemp. Mr. Sid. Williams of the rulings of the faculty.
