Pet. read from Mr. Murray asking to be allowed to take Lit. V privately and to be excused from Drawing. - Moved that request asking for Lit. privately be not granted. - 2d. carried. -

Moved that ^{Mr. Murray see entry} case regarding Drawing had already been considered and record made. - 2d. carried. -

2d. request read from Mr. Murray. Moved that the request be returned to him to be dated & properly worded on petition blank & to be put in proper form. - 2d. - carried. -

Mr. Callaway asks for permission to take Geom. Lat. Gen'l Hist. Biol. Phys.

Moved that the request be granted. - 2d. carried. -

Prof. Colrot makes the following resolution that the thesis required of the graduating class this year must in each case represent an amount of work equivalent to four hours

per week for one semester, in addition to the 128 hours required for graduation. - Rec. & carried. -

Board that students whose cards come under discussion must conform to the regulations. - The board. - carried. -
