UM STUDENTS SCHEDULED FOR JOB INTERVIEWS IN SEATTLE DURING BREAK MISSOULA --

About 60 University of Montana graduate and undergraduate students in business, computer science and interpersonal communication will spend part of their spring break interviewing for jobs in the Seattle area.

The students, who expect to be graduated this spring, are scheduled to interview March 21 in Bellevue, Wash., with 15 firms of the greater Seattle area.

UM's Office of Career Services arranged the interviews with the companies that otherwise would not have scheduled interviews on the UM campus, Director of Career Services Don Hjelmseth says.

About 15 students will go by van, and the other students will make other travel arrangements to the job interviews in order to spend more time there.
