162 April 4th 1900

Immediately after convocation the Faculty met in special session to consider a request of the Athletic Association for permission to give an entertainment. On motion the matter was referred to a com. — Profs. Mer, Elrod & Reiley were appointed the com. — After which the meeting adjourned.

163 April 5th 1900

Petition was read from Mr. W. J. McComick asking for reinstatement; his suspension being caused by 3 unexcused absences from Gymnasium practice. — M. 2. carried that Mr. McComick be reinstated on trial with three
