Resolved: That it is the judgement of the Faculty that the degrees B. Ph and B. S. be dispensed with, and that one degree be granted for all courses, in the University except the technical courses, and that recommendation for this change be made to the State Board of Education, but that the President be authorized to use his discretion in presenting the resolution to the State Board. -

M. that the minimum amount of work for thesis must represent 1 course or 4 credits
M. that the \$ read 3 courses maximum instead of two. -
