170 May 15 1900: 4¹⁵ P.M.-

Minutes read and approved.-

Com. on arrangement of programme for next year reported progress.

Moved that the rule on page 78 under regulation 2. be made to read:-

Only bona fide students in the University taking at least 8 hours per week of recitation or lecture etc. instead of 6 hours as at present.

Carried.-

Moved that the President appoint a Com. of three with the President as chairman to draft rules for the government of the Declamatory and Buckley societies.

Carried.-

President appointed Profs. Hubbell and Elrod.-

The Com. on Baud submitted the following amendment passed by the Baud

Sec III By Laws:- Resolved that a fine of ^{ten cents} be imposed upon each ^{member} who is absent from Baud practice, provided that he has been notified

of such practice.- This fine is to be imposed upon every member whether its absence would have been excusable or not and to take effect from this day Feb. 22^d 1900 A.D.

The Wharelor's recommended that the charge be authorized.- M. to approve the amendment

Carried.-

Sec IV Art. II recommended by the Baud that it be changed to read - that the Baud Treasurer be required to give bond of \$50 instead of \$200 as at the present time.-

Moved that the Secretary notify the Baud that (Sec IV Art III) the faculty decline to approve the amendment.- Carried.-

Moved to adjourn.- Carried
