SEVEN UM STUDENTS FROM MISSOULA SERVE COOPERATIVE EDUCATION INTERNSHIPS

MISSOULA --

Seven University of Montana students from Missoula are working as summer interns through UM's Cooperative Education Internship Program, through which they can earn academic credit.

Jim Bennett, who works with the Bureau of Land Management, is based in Lewistown. As a ranger, he learns about the Missouri River Wild and Scenic System and interprets Montana natural history to people visiting the river. He also compiles data, maintains campsites and tells visitors about BLM regulations, activities, services and facilities.

Michael "Jeff" Berglund, a 1984 graduate of Big Sky High School, is a loan review intern with First Interstate Bank in Missoula. A junior majoring in business administration, he helps review the bank's loan portfolio, examine loan files, prepare reports and maintain computer records.

David Bickerstaff, a junior majoring in geology, is helping UM graduate student in geology Warren Shepard with his research project. Bickerstaff, who works in Missoula, takes gravity readings and interprets the data using a computer.

Lynne Bowles, a 1984 graduate of Sentinel High School, is a management trainee with J.C. Penney in Missoula. A senior in

business management, she's working on sales leadership, time management, organization, setting sales goals, and communicating with the public and co-workers.

Robert Clark, a graduate student in rural, town and regional planning, interns with the Grand Coulee Dam Area Chamber of Commerce in Grand Coulee, Wash.
