to be allowed to drop Drawing. - Moved
that request be granted. - Sec'd - Carried.

Prof. Aber, Director of the Athletic Association asks faculty consent to expend \$8¹⁵ on debt. - Moved that request for permission to audit this bill be allowed. - Seconded - Carried.

189 Jan 15th 1901.

Regular meeting of the Faculty was held at 4.15 P.M.

Prof Scheuch being absent. Prof Riley was appointed secretary pro tem.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read & approved.

Prof. Aber, chairman of the Com. on Examination reported favorably in the case of Mr. Frederic Frazer and on motion Mr. Frazer was admitted to the Prep. Depart.

A petition from Miss Aggie Egan to drop English was read. - Moved, 2d. Carried that the petition be granted. -

After some informal discussion in regard to the opening of the gymnasium, Prof. Elrott moved that all students entering upon gymnasium work on or before Jan. 15th and continuing in this practice three times per week, until May 1st without being absent more than 3 times, be given a credit for one hour. - Motion carried, and details connected with putting the same into motion referred to the Com. on Athletics.

Adjourned until regular next meeting.
