Jan 15th 1901

The regular meeting of the Faculty was held at 4¹⁵ P.M. - Prof. Schuch briefly absent, Prof. Riley was appointed Secretary pro. tem.

After the reading and approval of the minutes of the preceding meeting, Prof. Elrot made an informal report in regard to the Luncheon Club.

A petition from Mr. Herbert Williams to drop Algebra and Latin was read, and on motion said petition was granted. -

Miss Ethel Ambrose petitioned to drop Latin, but on motion her petition was denied. Mr. Davies presented an outline of a proposed course in Library Economy and on motion of Prof. Elrot a course in said subject of (three) four hours per week was authorized. -

Mr. C. E. Byr was recommended by Prof. Harkins for entrance as a special student in Chemistry and Assaying. Moved seconded, and carried that Mr. Byr's application be referred to the President and Prof. Harkins with power to act.

Adjourned - J. C. Riley - Sec. pro. tem.

Jan. 22 - 4¹⁵ P.M. - Minutes (were read and) approved. - Dr. Craig reported that Mr. Byr had been enrolled and reported to classes. Miss Slaughter desires to drop German on acct. of poor health. M. 2d. that the report be granted. - Carried.

Mr. Sidney Ward requested the Faculty to be allowed to take an examination in Roman Law. - M. to grant the request. Sec. Carried. -

Petition signed by several students was

read, requesting the Faculty to allow them to organize a University Chess Club. -

Moved that they be informed that the faculty have no objection to their playing, but deem it unwise to sanction the formation of a University Club. -

Carried - M. that the Gymnasium work for Preparatory be recorded as a College credit and be applied as a (partial) elective in the College course. -

M. that a Program Com. be appointed to make changes in the Programme for the 2^d Semester. - Carried. - Com. appointed as follows: - Profs. Elrod, Aber, and Row. -

After general remarks and discussion adjourned. -

1902 February 7th 1901.

Meeting was called at 4¹⁵ P.M. - The minutes of the previous meeting were read, corrected and approved.

Petition was read from Mr. Geo. Weston for 21 hours work. - M. that the request be granted. - 2^d Carried. -

Miss Watson petitioned the Faculty to be allowed to take (sp) Course V French & Lrs. credit. - M. to allow her request. - 2^d - Carried. -

Mr. Wm Cochran asks that his credit in 2^d P. Latin be made a college credit. - The request on motion was denied and it was moved that Mr. Cochran be referred to the Chairman of Com. on grading & classification. Motion carried. -

Mr. Elmer Woodman asks to be allowed to substitute a 4 hour prep. course in Mechanical Drawing for Physiology. - Moved & seconded that the request be granted. - A substitute motion was made that the request be not granted. - Carried. -
