10 Whereas the Associated Students of The University of Montana (ASUM) passed Senate Bill
11 SB8-10/11, Resolution Regarding MontPIRG Fee Collection, December 8, 2010;

13 Whereas SB8-10/11 states, “That ASUM, at the end of the 2011 Spring Semester, calls for
14 MontPIRG to account for its funds in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles
15 and utilize effective and efficient internal control. Accountability of student fees must be
16 provided in an audit review or management review conducted by an independent CPA.”

18 Whereas MontPIRG presented ASUM with an audit that was not in accordance with generally
19 accepted accounting principles, was not conducted independently, and was not conducted by a
20 CPA;

22 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved the ASUM’s SB8-10/11 request was not satisfied,

24 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Montana
25 Kaimin, *the Board of Regents, the MontPIRG Board* and the President of The University of
