8	Whereas the College of Technology (COT) is an affiliated campus of the University of Montana;
9 10	Whereas the University of Montana COT has more than 2000 enrolled students which is a 28% increase over Fall 2008 enrollment figures;
11 12	Whereas the University of Montana Academic Strategic Planning Committee has articulated one of its primary goals as integration of the College of Technology;
13 14	Whereas the Associated Students of the University of Montana is the student government for The University of Montana-Missoula campuses;
15	Whereas COT students are eligible to vote in ASUM elections and hold office;
16	Whereas the ASUM executives have the power to appoint ex-officio members of the Senate;
17 18	Whereas the allowance of representatives of the College of Technology at weekly meetings would ensure a voice for the College of Technology students;
19 20 21	Therefore Let it Be Resolved that the Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) appoint a student enrolled in the College of Technology as an ex-officio member of the Senate for the duration of the 2009-2010 academic year;
