9 Whereas, current fiscal policy requires the Senate Emergency Contingency Fund to never
10 drop below the amount to cover three employees with the most longevity;

12 Whereas, ASUM already funds all ASUM employees in the Senate Emergency
13 Contingency Fund;

15 Whereas, ASUM will save over \$20,000.00 by funding the Senate Emergency
16 Contingency Fund at 80% of the amount necessary to cover all ASUM classified
17 employees;

19 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that ASUM amends Section 13.1 to read:

20 13.1 ~~At least twice~~ *Once* each calendar year, the Accountant shall determine the amount
21 which would be owed if ~~the three~~ *all* ASUM classified employees ~~with the most~~
22 longevity terminated employment. ~~At no time shall this time~~ the Senate Emergency
23 Contingency Fund *should be funded to 80% of* ~~drop below~~ the amount necessary to
24 cover the departure of these ~~three~~ *three* aforementioned employees.
