11   Whereas, over 2,500 students (approximately 20% of the student population) have signed  
12   a petition in support of the MontPIRG fee being placed on the spring ASUM ballot;

13  
14   Whereas, the ASUM bylaws require the signatures of 5% of the student population in  
15   support of a fee for that fee to be placed on the ballot;

16  
17   Therefore, Let It Be Resolved that ASUM will place the question of a \$5.00 refundable  
18   fee to be placed on the ballot this spring for the 2010-2011 ~~and 2011-2012~~ academic  
19   years;

20  
21   Let It Be Further Resolved that the ballot language will read as follows:

23   “MontPIRG (Montana Public Interest Research Group) is a statewide, student directed,  
24   non-profit, non-partisan advocacy organization. MontPIRG exists to articulate and pursue  
25   through the media, the institutions of government, research, the courts, and other legal  
26   means the concerns of students on issues of general public interests. These issues include,  
27   but are not limited to college affordability, protecting the environment, alleviating hunger  
28   and homelessness, increasing public transportation and consumer protection. MontPIRG  
29   empowers students by ~~pools ing their student~~ resources to hire professional staff that  
30   works with students, ~~giving themselves the skills, knowledge and presence needed to~~  
31   ~~make meaningful and lasting change. to teach skills in community organizing.~~

33   Do you support the funding of a MontPIRG chapter at the University of Montana through  
34   a \$5 per student, per semester refundable fee? Any student not wanting to pay the fee can  
35   get a refund.”
