The minutes of the previous meeting were not read. Moved that a resolution <sup>be adopted</sup> commending an adoption of a School of Commerce to the State Board. - Carried.

Moved that from and after Sept '02. all subjects in the Preparatory be scheduled 5 times per week instead of 4 as at present. - Those having Lab. work, meet 3 hours and 2 labor. periods.

Moved to postpone <sup>action</sup> to the next faculty meeting. Carried. - Moved that there be no University exercises on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup>. Arbor Day - Carried. -

Adjourned to meet on call.

251 Wednesday, 7<sup>th</sup> 1902.

The meeting was called at 4:15 by Pres't Craig. - The minutes of the previous meet. were not read. - Moved that Mr. Jennings' registration be approved - for fewer than 15 points - approved by consent - (same with registration of Mrs. Jennings).

Moved that the proposed registration of Mr. Pope in Mech. Draw. be approved - Carried.

Moved that the amount of credit given Miss Latman in Chemistry be accepted in lieu of required work in Chemistry. - Carried.

On page 66. of catalogue. - made to read: - Scientific course I, II, III, IV, V, VI  
 X or XI - two years in ancient or mod. language and <sup>one of</sup> IV, X, XI, XII and XIII

Moved to add on page 70 after clause IX - but at least 1/2 work shall be residence work. - Carried.



A motion was made and carried that on page 81 - that 2 years of science and ancient or modern languages be required for preparation to the Scientific Course. Moved to add to fees:-
