January 24, 1972 Public Hearing

The committee met briefly at 9 a.m. in Room 432 prior to the public hearing. The committee schedule was presented and will be printed for distribution to committee members. Mae Nan Robinson will present background on the Legislative Council for the committee. Arlyne Reichert will present background on the Legislative Audit for the committee.

Chairman Aasheim called the Public Hearing meeting to order at 10 a.m. Roll call was taken.

#### WITNESSES

Dr. Larry Pettit, University of Montana, Bozeman, testified (see testimony filed herewith). Questions and answers followed.

Bob Buzzas, intern for Constitutional Convention, testified (see testimony filed herewith). Ouestions and answers followed.

Carl Rostad, Helena, representing the Montana Youth Constitutional Convention testified. The Youth Convention voted by 2/3 to have a unicameral system. He reminded members that the youth of Montana will have to live with the decisions of the Constitutional Convention. Ouestions and answers followed.

Howard Banks, interested citizen from Helena, testified in behalf of a unicameral system.

Diane Schladweiler, Bozeman, testified for the League of Women Voters (see testimony filed herewith). Questions and answers followed.

Jean Anderson, Billings, League of Women Voters, read the last half of the testimony. Questions and answers followed.

The hearing was recessed until 1:30 p.m.
