10 Whereas, many problems arise when the UM Bookstore does not have
11 an adequate amount of textbooks for students when school starts;

13 Whereas, problems often stem from faculty submitting textbook
14 orders late to the UM Bookstore;

16 Whereas, textbooks generally take about 3 weeks to be scanned
17 and ready to use by vision-impaired students, late textbook
18 orders especially inconvenience disabled students;

20 Whereas, students can not sell certain textbooks back to the UM
21 Bookstore during buyback period if orders of these textbooks
22 came late from faculty;

24 Whereas, textbook delays have a negative impact to students'
25 class preparations;

27 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved that ASUM encourages faculty to
28 order text books as early as possible, keeping in mind the delay
29 for scanning.
