Whenever possible students should
 obtain permission for the absence before
 it occurs.

Students will immediately upon
 returning after absence present their
 excuses to the different professors and
 instructors.

Students who do not present an
 excuse within two days from time
 of notification of the absence will
 have such absence or absences stand
 as unexcused.

Students having 3 unexcused absences
 from any class thereby suspend them-
 selves from all work until adjustment
 is made by the faculty.

Professors and instructors will
 notify students when two unexcused
 absences have accumulated,
 and at the same time notify the
 President.
