The meeting was called by Pres Craig. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved after correction.

Com. on ^{recommendations for} delinquent students. Reported progress and asked for more time, which was allowed.

Petition was read from Miss King asking to be allowed to drop 3d Prep. German - On not allowed.

A petition was read from the members of the Ladies Basket Ball teams asking that they be excused from work at 3³⁰ - Moved that the matter of leaving students at 3³⁰ be left to the heads of the different departments.

III Absences

[Collegiate students who desire to be absent from any recitation or other exercise are required whenever possible to obtain leave of absence from the Prof. in charge.

In case, ^{the} student is unable to obtain such leave of absence beforehand, he shall immediately on returning present his excuse to the different Professors ^{and} instructors.

If a satisfactory excuse is not rendered within two days after a student's return from such absence it shall be marked unexcused.

Professors and instructors will notify students when two unexcused absences have accumulated and at the same time notify the President.

Students having 3 unexcused absences from any one subject thereby suspend themselves from all classes.

When a student has been absent three consecutive times from any recitation or laboratory practice in any one subject such absence shall be reported to the Office.

The foregoing rules shall apply to the Preparatory students, except that the excuse must be obtained from the Vice President instead of from the Professor & Instructor
