Whereas, the ASUM Senate approved SB53, supporting the question of if the Montana Kaimin fee proposal should be sent to student referendum,

Therefore, Let It Be Resolved that the ASUM Senate approves the following language to be placed on the ballot in the April 2009 referendum and election process:

Montana Kaimin

The Montana Kaimin is proposing a \$2.00 increase to the Montana Kaimin fee. The Montana Kaimin is the only student run newspaper for the University of Montana and employs almost 50 students to prepare and design the ~~daily~~ *weekday* publication. ~~This fee would be used to~~ *They ask for this increase for the purposes of modernizing* the technology of the ~~Montana Kaimin office organization~~, ~~maintaining~~ necessary *financial* reserves, ~~meeting~~ mandatory increases in the minimum wage, and ~~continuing~~ to provide special advertising rates to student groups.
